

EXPERIMENTAL DISCIPLINARY PLAYING RULES - HURLING

Sanction - Player Ordered off & **NOT** Replaced

- 5.1 To strike or attempt to strike an opponent with head, arm elbow hand or knee
- 5.2 To strike or attempt to strike an opponent with a Hurley with minimal force
- 5.3 To strike an opponent with a Hurley, either with force or causing injury
- 5.4 To attempt to strike an opponent with a Hurley with force
- 5.5 To kick or attempt to kick an opponent with minimal force
- 5.6 To kick an opponent either with force or causing injury
- 5.7 To attempt to kick an opponent with force
- 5.8 To stamp on an opponent
- 5.9 To behave in any way which is dangerous to an opponent
- 5.10 To inflict injury recklessly on an opponent by means other than stated above
- 5.11 To spit at an opponent
- 5.12 To contribute to a melee
- 5.13 To strike or attempt to strike, to interfere with or use threatening or abusive language or conduct to a Match Official
- 5.14 To assault an opposing team official
- 5.15 To foul a team-mate as in Rule 5.1-5.11
- 5.16 To foul an opponent as in Rule 5.4-5.11 prior to the start, at half time or after the game.

1ST Foul in this Category = 

Sanction - Player Sent off & Replaced by Substitute (Highly Disruptive Fouls)

- (1) To pull down an opponent
- (2) To trip an opponent with hand (s), foot or hurley
- (3) To deliberately body collide with an opponent after he has played the ball away or for the purpose of taking him out of a movement of play
- (4) To bring an arm or hurley around the neck of an opponent
- (5) To wrestle with an opponent, on the ground, and away from play
- (6) To remonstrate in an aggressive manner with a Match Official
- (7) To use the hurley in a careless manner



1ST Foul in this Category = 

Sanction – 1st Infraction = Black Book

Repeat Infraction: Black Book + Yellow Card i.e. Player Sent off & Replaced by Substitute

- 5.19 To threaten/use abusive or provocative language/gestures to an opponent
- 5.20 To engage in rough play
- 5.21 To make a “pull” with the hurley from behind and around the body of an opponent that is not consistent with an attempt to play the ball
- 5.23 To throw the hurley in a manner with constitutes danger to another player(s)
- 5.24 To pull/take hold of a faceguard or any other part of an opponent’s helmet
- 5.25 To attempt to achieve advantage by feigning a foul or injury
- 5.26 To threaten or use abusive or provocative language or gestures to a team-mate
- 5.27 To hold an opponent with the hand(s)
- 5.28 (a) To charge an opponent in the back or front
 - (b) To charge an opponent unless:
 - (i) He is in possession of the ball
 - (ii) He is playing the ball
 - (iii) Both players are moving in the direction of the ball to play it
 - (c) To charge an opponent for the purpose of giving advantage to a team-mate

1ST Foul in this Category = 


2nd Foul in this Category =  + 

Sanction – 3rd Infraction = Black Book

4th Infraction = Black Book + Yellow Card i.e. Player Sent off & Replaced by Substitute

- 5.29 (a) To push an opponent with the hand(s) or hurley
 - (b) To hold opponent’s Hurley or pull it from his hands
- 5.30 (a) To charge the goalkeeper in the small rectangle
 - (b) For a player in possession of the ball to charge an opponent
- 5.31 To use the hurley to obstruct an opponent
- 5.32 To strike an opponent’s hurley unless both players are in the act of striking the ball
